Jacksonville is the commercial center of Onslow County and home to the Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and the Marine Corps Air Station New River. Early growth for Jacksonville began with the establishment of a court house in 1755. The town was later incorporated in 1842 and named Jacksonville after President Andrew Jackson. In 1941 construction began on a Marine Corps Training Center, later named Camp Lejeune after Lt. General John A. Lejeune. Today, the Base covers over 150,000 acres and has become a stable economic force for Onslow County. Both Camp Lejeune and New River Air Station are home to the largest Marine force in the world. As you can imagine, Jacksonville, North Carolina, together with a diverse combination of people and plain old southern hospitality, makes for a very interesting visit.

ELIGIBILITY

The Jimmy Anderson Junior Invitational is open to boys and girls between the ages of 13 and 18. Entrants must meet the age requirements as of April 26, 2009.

FORMAT

The tournament consists of 36 holes of stroke play, 18 holes each day.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The tournament committee reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the tournament. Use of tobacco products by competitors is prohibited. Each competitor must walk and carry his or her own bag during the stipulated round. Caddies will not be permitted.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the girls' and boys' champion and the top 3 places in each division. A tie for the overall championship in either division will be broken by an on course playoff beginning on a hole to be determined. All other ties will be broken by the USGA recommended system of "matching scorecards".

ENTRIES

Each competitor must complete an official entry form. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Registration is open until 5 pm on Wednesday, April 15, 2009. Tournament committee is not responsible for errors or delay by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance is sent by email to the competitor when their status is determined.

ENTRY FEE

Each competitor is required to pay the entry fee of \$100. Please make check payable to Jacksonville Country Club. No refunds after April 15, 2009.

PRACTICE ROUND

Practice rounds were not included in the entry fee. Practice rounds will be available on April 11-19 when space is available. The fee for practice rounds is \$15 (walking) and is open to players and parents. Please call the Jacksonville CC golf shop to schedule practice round date and time.

PARENT POLICY

Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

MEASURING DEVICES

Devices that measure distance only may be used during this championship.
