ELIGIBILITY

All members of a team must attend the same middle school. A middle school student is defined as a student who is in grades 6-8 during the current school year. A maximum of six players may represent a school. However, if no girls are on the team, that school is limited to five participants. Any number of girls may play for a school. Home-schooled players and private school students and teams are allowed. A maximum of two individuals per school may participate if not part of a team. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the TYGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Tarheel Youth Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship or qualifying. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Each competitor must walk and carry his or her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie who must walk also. **Caddies over the age of 18 are not permitted. A team may designate one person to act as a coach, and that coach will be allowed to give advice only between the play of two holes.**

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 36-holes of stroke play. All players, regardless of gender, will play from the same tees (approx. 5500 yards). Each team must return four individual 18-hole scores per day to qualify for the team championship. On-course playoffs to determine individual champion(s) and/or team champions will be used when the need is identified. Players are responsible for making themselves available.

CHAMPIONSHIP PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the championship team, all members of the championship team, the individual boys' champion and the individual girls' champion.

ENTRIES

Each school or school representing individual(s) must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the open date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the close date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance will be sent to the coach or the school representing the individual(s) when their status is determined. Status will be updated weekly at www.tyga.org.

Entries must be returned to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each school or individual and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check.

Make check payable to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association. A school whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from TYGA competitions. Refunds will not be made after September 14. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Pairings and starting times will be posted at the club and at www.tyga.org the day before the championship. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.
