Eligibility:

- Must be 8 - 18 years of age as of the date of the event and have not started college.
- Must be a resident of N.C.



One player per entry and one check per entry. Enclose entry fee payable to TYGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC. All entrants must complete an official entry form. Entries received prior to the opening date will be returned. Entries will be accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the close date or until the field is filled. Entries must be returned to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association (see above address). Fax, e-mail, telephone, late, or incomplete entries will not be accepted. **Confirmation of acceptance will be sent via e-mail only and posted at www.tyga.org.** No refunds will be given after entries close. TYGA is not responsible for error and/or delays with any mail courier.

Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the tournament, by the Carolinas Golf Association, the Tarheel Youth Golf Association, or the host club. The reason may include unbecoming conduct. Players failing to show without either notifying the CGA office or the host site prior to the event may be subject to rejection from future events.

Divisions will be as follows: Boys 14-18, Boys 12-13, Girls 12-13, Girls 14-18, Under 11 (9 holes only). TYGA reserves the right to modify the divisions based on entries. The field will be limited to the 84 players. The boy's 14-18 age division and girls 14-18 age division will be determined based off of the TYGA NC junior rankings as of **September 1, 2006**. The other division will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.

Each competitor must walk and carry his or her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 or younger (no exceptions) and must walk. Tee time assignments will be made available at the host site 7 days prior to the event and at www.tyga.org. **Practice rounds are not included in the tournament entry fee.** Cell phones and tobacco products are prohibited.
